
JND468 – Purse Box Version 2 – 4th October 2024 - by John Lockwood





Instructions by June Smith

John has created a 'You Tube Video' dated 4th October 2024, using the new JND468 Purse Box Version 2, where he demonstrates how to make a stunning Purse Box, this is the picture on the packaging. I would advise that you visit it as well as following these instructions.

Information:

Just using 2 A4 sheets of card we can make this stunning Purse Box. Or a matching Purse which is on a separate video. The die is exactly 8¼", the measurements of an A4 card. For the purposes of these instructions, I have referred the side folds of the box as 'Y'.











Materials


JND468 Purse Box Die JND467 Greeting Panels (4) Gold Waterfall Glitter card Die Cutting Machine 2mm Foam Tape Craft Kit

Method:


 Cut out the Purse Box die twice from Gold Waterfall card. Fold and reinforce all the fold lines. Add 6mm blue powertape down the left-hand side of each. Then add onto the bottom edge of the Y mechanism, which is the side fold mechanism of the purse. On one piece only add blue tape along the bottom.




 On the right-hand panel, cut the bottom folded tab off. Turn the panel over and on the back add a strip of Powertape across the bottom and just below the fold line, this is going to help strengthen the bottom. Fold the top halfmoon panel over, then take your scissors and cut this panel off. Don't throw this piece away because you can use it to decorate another box or die cut things out if it.




 Remove the blue powertape covering from all that you can see and adhere all the folds over, finishing off with the base panel that has the 2 strips of powertape on it.



Then fold the top flap over to create your purse.



 You could add ribbon around the flap as a hanger for the purse or fold it over with a Magnet or Velcro. Or if you look at the photo below you can see a couple of beautiful samples from Leslie Lakin.



- You could also close it with powertape. It is then up you how you decorate it.
- John has used the spray from the Pinecones die, the script embossing folder on the front. Flowers and blue ribbon.



Your creation is now complete. I hope you have enjoyed these instructions.
